Redemption Kids Lesson (James 1:19-25)

Note to Parents: At Redemption Church we believe in the importance of family worship. During this time, you as a parent have an amazing opportunity to worship at home together with your children. I will be sending out lessons for you to go through with your children along with some games, songs and even some family competitions! Take this time to dive deep into God's word with your little ones. God can move in great ways, even in quarantine.

Opening Activity:

Act out James 1:19 with your child. When you say "quick to listen" he should run really fast. When you say "slow to speak", he should walk slowly, and when you say "slow to become angry" he should stop. Do this several times to see if he can memorize the verse.

Lesson:

Have you ever been angry? What do you do when you're angry? Read James 1:19-21 How does God want us to respond to anger?

Read Ephesians 4:26

This verse tells us that it's okay to be angry. Everyone gets angry! However, when we are angry, we should not sin. What are some ways we sin when we are angry? This verse also tells us to get over our angry quickly – don't go to bed angry!

Read James 1:22-25

These verses tell us that we need to do what the Bible says! If we don't do what the Bible says, it's just like if we look in a mirror and then go away and forget what we look like! That's silly, isn't it?
