

Redemption Kids Lesson (James 3:13-18)

Note to Parents: At Redemption Church we believe in the importance of family worship. During this time, you as a parent have an amazing opportunity to worship at home together with your children. I will be sending out lessons for you to go through with your children along with some games, songs and even some family competitions! Take this time to dive deep into God's word with your little ones. God can move in great ways, even in quarantine.

Opening activity:

Make a "helping hands" book. Trace your child's hands on several pieces of construction paper. On each hand, have your child write, draw, or glue pictures of ways he can do good. Punch a hole in each hand and let your child put yarn or ribbon through it and tie it together to make a little book. Read through the book together, emphasizing that one way we show we have wisdom is by the way we behave.

Lesson:

Read James 3:13-15. Did you know that when you have good behavior, you show that you are wise? What are some ways that you can have good behavior?

Read James 3:16-18. What kind of fruit are you sowing? Does your life have the qualities of wisdom that are listed in these verses, or are you growing something else? Ask God to help you grow good things!!

Make a fruit salad today as you talk about the fruits of wisdom!

Read Matthew 7:15-20. What kind of tree are you? Are you producing good fruits or bad? How can you produce good fruits? Make a [fruit tree craft](#) today.
